- The tables below shows BTP "02A Sex" offences that were completed from 01/01/2025 to 31/12/2025, where an Outcome was applied indicating that the crime was solved. (Outcomes 1 to 9 in England & Wales and Outcomes DET1 to DET9 in Scotland). Crimes may be solved other than through charge/summons.
