4. Where held, a breakdown by detailed offence type or Home Office offence classification.

For clarity, I am requesting aggregate statistical data only. I am not requesting names, addresses, dates of birth, victim information, case summaries, or free-text crime reports. Please provide the information in CSV or Excel format if possible.

Complaint Rights
